

Cool time-lapse video shows building of Saints' stadium from beginning to end

After \$64.7 million spent, 7,000 seats installed and a crap-load of soil pollution clean up, the St. Paul Saints are playing in their new home. We hear the views are great, the Summit is flowing and fans are enjoying the fruits of their tax dollars and nearly two years of labor.

It felt like a long wait. But thanks to a cool time-lapse video put together by Ryan Companies and [Work Zone Cam](#), you can watch CHS Field being built in about a minute, set to a soothing instrumental track.
